Key Responsibilities

1. To observe the trial/Legal proceedings in support of the victims of GBV serviced by CLMPU and report back to CLMPU on a monthly basis.
2. To determine that the criminal law has dealt with the case effectively to ensure justice is served for the victims and finalized.
3. To provide extra capacity for the victim to ensure the victim understands the legal proceedings and what is expected from the victim.
4. To track all the GBV cases under CLMPU and report on each case progress in court on a monthly basis.
5. To provide an advisory role, where possible for the victim to influence acceleration of the GBV court cases where there are delays/backlog dating far back as April 2019.
6. To partner with CLMPU when conducting awareness campaigns to provide legal guidance to prevent or combat against gender based violence for all victims.
